We are saddened to hear of the following deaths.

Meredith Middleton (Macmillan) Meredith was affectionately called *Podge*. She joined Morongo in 1948 in sub-intermediate and left after Matriculating in 1952

Marjorie Menzies (Cook) began her education in the Morongo kindergarten in 1927 and matriculated in 1941. She was a prefect.

Marjorie went on to complete her Primary Teacher Training at ATTI. She commenced her professional life back at Roslyn, the Morongo nursery school in Elizabeth Street, Newtown in 1944. It was in that same year, in that same kindergarten, that five little 4/5/6 year olds began their Morongo education! Denise Hargreaves, Pamela Lilburne (Kemp), Judy Lindsay (Williams), Marlene Metherall (Ryan) and Faye Pope (Lee)!! We spent 4 years in Miss Cook's loving care and what wonderful, happy, busy years they were. We were often allowed to drag our big double desks outside where we would spent the entire day!! The five of us bonded into a close friendship group which still remains to this day, although sadly we are now only three. We firmly believe that it was the love and guidance shown us by Marjorie Cook that inspired four of that original five to enter the teaching profession and love it for many years. After Marjorie's 6 children were well settled into school life, she joined the staff at St. Leonards School in Brighton where she became Head of the Junior School, teaching for 8 years. The Marjorie Menzies Hall was built in her honour. We remained friends until Marjorie died last year in her ninety-second year.
